Waste Management *by Walter Nerling*

We look forward to 2020 and are anxiously awaiting what the Lord has planned for us at Bethel Park. We have been working hard to move the Waste Management project forward. After many months of delay, the Ministry of Environment decided that the approval for our collection system must be obtained from the local Municipality of West Elgin. I am thankful to report that we received our permit from West Elgin in early January allowing us to proceed.

Required preparations had to be made in order to get the large crane and trucks around the corner at Motel B. The location of the existing electrical panel did not allow for enough room for the trucks and crane to make the turn. The large concrete tanks for the Newterra Plant have been installed, and the tanks for the two Pumping Stations are on site and being installed.

Below you will see what our Newterra Plant looks like. A-Xcavating, our local site contractor, expects to pour a

concrete pad once we have warmer weather, possibly in the middle of April. The Plant is expected to be ready by the end of March but cannot be delivered until the concrete pad has been poured.

As of the end of 2019 we have paid out \$395,000.00 towards this project with another invoice for \$105,000 being processed. Thank you for your prayers and faithfulness in giving towards this capital project so that work can continue.

Again, our financial obligations were met for 2019 and we thank you for your financial support during 2019. When you receive the 2019 financial statement package, you will see we have continued to keep our normal yearly camp operating expenses as low as possible.

As mentioned in the 2019 Fall Newsletter, during the Chapel/Dining Hall/Kitchen major renovation project in 2002-03, several members lent funds to Bethel Park at that time. The Bethel Park Board of Directors would prefer to receive loans from Bethel Park cabin owners/members rather than going through a financial

institution. There would be a "Loan Agreement" between the person(s) and Bethel Park Camp, stating interest rate and conditions. Each agreement will be negotiated individually. Our general guideline for the interest rate you receive would be somewhere between the interest one would receive on your Savings Account from a financial institution to a reasonable Guaranteed Interest Certificate one would receive from a financial institution.
